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Shepherd's Home Volunteers are needed in the following areas:

Relief House Parents

Relief House Parents are the volunteers, who stay at the Home for an hour, a day, a weekend or more, in order to give our regular House Parents needed respite or relief. This volunteer position requires a background check and some training. Currently licensed foster parents are fully qualified to be Relief House Parents.

Mentoring and Recreation

Shepherd's Home residents love to take part in outdoor or indoor activities, or may need tutoring help in school. This volunteer position requires a background check.

Fundraising Event(s)

The Shepherd's Home holds several fundraising events each year. It is hard to say for certain which is more fun -- volunteering or attending one of these events. Our largest fundraiser is our annual golf tournament held in August. Volunteers are needed before and during this event to help with mailings, auction items, and to help out on the course and at the dinner.
